The bar was finished by January, 1993. Our membership started to grow. The few members we had worked really hard. One night we got a group together to put a door in a wall that would open it up to both rooms. It took 8 hours and 6 men to break through and 3 trailers of rock and wood,. But alas, we had a bar and a meeting room. The ceiling was painted by Dick Flury who lost a finger while painting. Things were really starting to shape up. Next month, "no name storm."
